HOW TO CONTINUE GROWING

1. Fix a daily time with God

"And now, dear children, <u>continue to live in fellowship</u> with Christ..." I John 2:28 (NLT)

"Everyone who lives in union with Christ does not continue to sin..." 1 John 3:6 (TEV)

"Continue praying, keeping alert, and always thanking God." Col. 4:2 (NCV)

2. Fill my mind with scripture

"The truly happy people are those who <u>carefully study</u> God's perfect law that makes people free, and they continue to <u>study it</u>. They do not forget what they heard, but they obey what God's teaching says." James 1:25 (NCV)

"If you <u>continue in my word</u>, then you are my disciples indeed; And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall <u>make you free</u>." John 8:31-32 (KJV)

3. Focus on my goal, not my habit

"I do not mean that I am already as God wants me to be. I have not yet reached that <u>goal</u>, but <u>I continue trying to reach it</u> and to make it mine. Christ wants me to do that, which is the reason he made me his." Phil. 3:12 (NCV)
