Luke 23:32-34 (NIV)

³² Two other men, both criminals, were also led out with him to be executed.

³³ When they came to the place called the Skull, there they crucified him, along with the criminals--one on his right, the other on his left.

³⁴ Jesus said, "**Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing.**" And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.
