2 Corinthians 3:15-18 (NIV)

¹⁷ *Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.*

John 8:33-36 (NIV)

³⁶ *So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.*

Galatians 5:1 (NIV)

¹ *It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery.*

Romans 6:22-23 (NIV)

²² *But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life..*

Psalms 119:45 (NIV)

Galatians 5:13-14 (NIV)
