1 Corinthians 7

- 1 Corinthians 7:1 (NIV)
- ¹ Now for the matters you wrote about: It is good for a man not to marry.
- 1 Corinthians 7:19 (NIV)
- ¹⁹ Circumcision is nothing and uncircumcision is nothing. Keeping God's commands is what counts.

Seek to discern the <u>principles</u> and <u>character</u> of God and His Word.

- 1 Corinthians 7:26 (NIV)
- ²⁶ Because of the present crisis, I think that it is good for you to remain as you are.
- 1 Corinthians 7:17 (NIV)
- ¹⁷ Nevertheless, each one should retain the place in life that the Lord assigned to him and to which God has called him. This is the rule I lay down in all the churches.
- 1 Corinthians 5:9-10 (NIV)
- ⁹ I have written you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral people-¹⁰ not at all meaning the people of this world who are immoral, or the greedy and swindlers, or idolaters. In that case you would have to leave this world.

John 17:15-18 (NIV)

- ¹⁵ My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.
- ¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of it.
- ¹⁷ Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth.
- ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world.

In most cases, God wants us to bloom where we are planted.

- 1 Corinthians 7:22 (NIV)
- ²² For he who was a slave when he was called by the Lord is the Lord's freedman; similarly, he who was a free man when he was called is Christ's slave.
- 1 Corinthians 7:35 (NIV)
- ³⁵ I am saying this for your own good, not to restrict you, but that you may live in a right way in undivided devotion to the Lord.

Bottom Line:

Make the <u>choices</u> necessary to live in <u>undivided devotion</u> to the Lord.
